<p>3. <u>Hazards identification</u></p>	<p>This product is not classified as hazardous. Do not mix with or store close to acids or cleaners. gases (chlorine) may be liberated.</p>								
<p>4. <u>First-aid measures</u></p>	<p>Skin contact: Upon prolonged contact with skin, the product may cause slight skin irritation. Wash affected area thoroughly with water.</p> <p>Eye contact: If the product gets into the eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water for least 5 minutes.</p> <p>Ingestion: If accidental ingestion should occur, drink plenty of water or milk. Do not induce vomiting. any symptoms persist, seek medical advice.</p> <p>Inhalation: If irritation should occur, rinse mouth and throat with water and move to fresh air.</p>								
<p>5. <u>Fire fighting measures</u></p>	<p>The product itself is non-flammable. If product or packaging are involved in a fire, toxic chlorine may be released. Use CO₂, dry chemical powders or alcohol resistant foam. If water is used, run-off.</p>

If irritant effects are seen, these will be mild to moderate, depending on exposure. If in contact with eyes flushing with water is recommended.</p> <p>Estimated acute oral toxicity: LD50 (rats) > 2g/Kg</p> <p>Skin irritation: May cause slight skin irritation</p> <p>Eye irritation: May cause transient superficial irritation</p> <p>Mutagenicity: Not mutagenic</p> <p>Sensitisation: No evidence of skin sensitisation</p>

12. Ecological information	Ingredients have a known ecotoxicity supporting their safe use. The hypochlorite decomposes to water and a small amount of common salt.
13. Disposal considerations	Sluice to waste with plenty of water. Dispose of packaging with normal household waste.
14. Transport information	Not classified. No special precautions.
15. Regulatory information	Classified as non-dangerous in accordance with Directive 88/379/EEC and local implementation. All ingredients are EINECS registered.
